- You may only show **ONE** exhibit in each category.
- The hall will be closed for Judging and will only reopen once finished.
- All exhibits **MUST NOT** be removed before 16.00. All exhibits are to be removed from the hall by 17.00; if they are not removed, they will be sold or disposed of.
- A table top exhibit sale will commence at 17.00 for non collected exhibits or those offered for sale as noted on the exhibitors card.
- Please label clearly any baking entries that may contain nuts.
- The Sunflower competition is open to all age groups. Send entries by email to the Fete Committee: woodcotefete@gmail.com. Winners to be announced at the Fete where your photos will be on display. **Closing date is 2 days prior to the day of the Fete.**
- Any exhibits entered in this fete must not have been entered in any other show.
- **All exhibits are left at the owner's risk.**
- The judge's decision must be accepted as final.
